



Building on Endoscopic Principles: UBE builds upon the foundation laid by earlier endoscopic spine surgeries, particularly uniportal endoscopy, which aimed to minimize tissue trauma and recovery time.

Refinement of Techniques: UBE involves the continuous refinement of surgical techniques, instrumentation, and visualization technologies, leading to improved outcomes and expanding clinical applications.

Expanding Indications: UBE's applications have broadened over time, moving beyond simple disc herniations to address conditions like spinal stenosis, instability, and even cervical and thoracic issues.

Growing Body of Evidence: The increasing number of research papers and clinical studies focusing on UBE demonstrates its growing acceptance and refinement within the medical community.

Reduced Tissue Trauma and Faster Recovery: While sharing the benefits of minimally invasive surgery with other endoscopic techniques, UBE's biportal approach may offer further advantages in terms of reduced tissue damage, shorter hospital stays, and faster recovery times.

Dr. Parviz Kambin was the first to describe a working space within the intervertebral foramen, through which the spinal canal can be safely accessed. Due to its somewhat triangular shape, this safe zone was termed the "Kambin triangle".
